New Consumer Agenda: where do we stand?

The European Commission is expected to adopt on 14 December 2021 two initiatives announced in the November 2020 New Consumer Agenda.

The two initiatives planned for 14 December 2021 are a proposal for a Directive empowering the consumer for the green transition and a proposal for a Regulation on substantiating green claims. This timeline, indicated in the latest planning of Commissioners' meetings may still be subject to delays, as has already been the case in the past.

As a reminder, on the basis of the New Consumer Agenda, the Commission is also expected to update the guidance documents on the Unfair Commercial Practices Directive and the <u>Consumer Rights</u> <u>Directive</u> by 2022. The update will address the amendments introduced by the Better enforcement and modernisation Directive and the new case law and market developments.
