Title of relevant section	Provisions concerning the documentation used for marketing, promotion and technical manuals, from article 8 of the Decree
Clauses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When referring to a car brand/ make and not to a specific model, FC&amp;CO2 data do not need to be included</li> <li>• When featuring one car model where all its versions have the same level of FC&amp;CO2 data, only the FC&amp;CO2 data of the featured model must be stated</li> <li>• When featuring different car models or one model with several versions with different levels of CO2 emissions or fuel consumption, only the minimum and maximum (i.e. the lowest and highest) levels of FC&amp;CO2 for the models or versions in question must be referenced</li> <li>• CO2 emissions must be stated to the nearest round number in grams per kilometre (g/km).</li> <li>• Fuel consumption must be stated accurate to one decimal place, in litres per 100 kilometre (l/100km), or in cubic metres per 100 kilometres (m<sup>3</sup>/100 km) if the car runs on natural gas</li> <li>• The emission's category (from A to G as defined in Annex I of the April 2003 Minister Order - see link in Section E or here: <a href="http://www.g-regs.com/downloads/FREnEfClass.pdf">http://www.g-regs.com/downloads/FREnEfClass.pdf</a></li> </ul> <p>from one or several models featured may be included (at points of sale this information is mandatory)</p>
