Title of relevant sections

Articles 1 (2) of the Framework Law and Articles 2 (2) and 2 (3) Presidential Decree 272/1998

Definitions

Alcoholic beverages: more than 1.2% ABV

Strong Spirits: more than 21% ABV

(Art. 1 (2) Framework Law)

Light beer: 1.2% - 3.5% ABV (5° Plato to 10.5°)

Plato is a fermentation scale: https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Beer_measurement

Beer: ABV greater than 3.5% (degrees Plato not less than 10,5°): this product may be called:

- Special beer: if the degrees Plato is in the range of 12.5° - 14.5°;
- Stout: if the degrees Plato is not less than 14.5°
